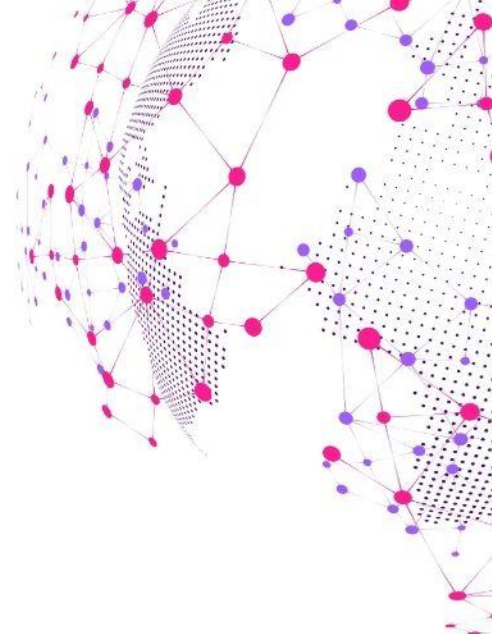

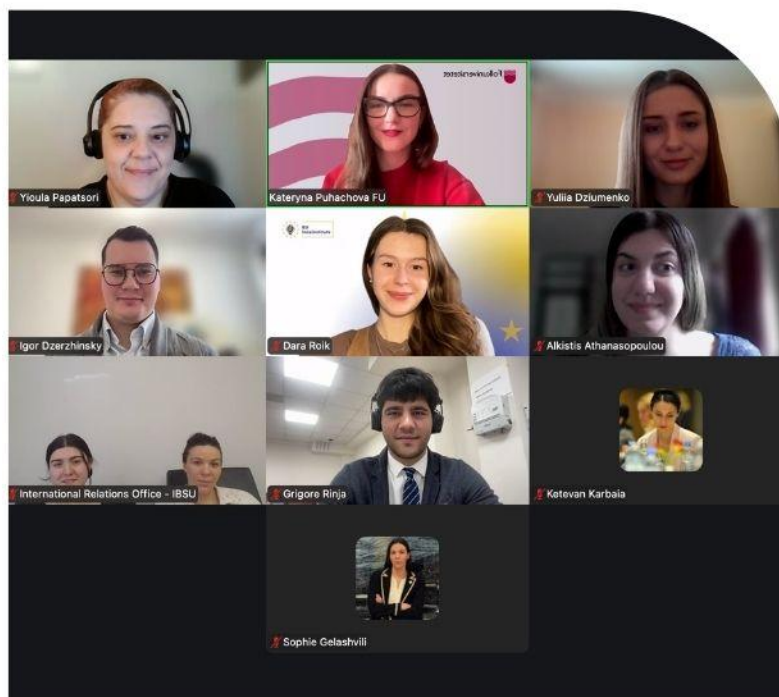

Big news: VirtuallyEDU 2.0 is officially live! 🚀 This fresh Erasmus+ project is all about giving young people the tools to question, challenge, and shape the digital world — instead of just scrolling through it. Over the next three years, we're bringing together 2,500+ young people aged 18–30 from five countries to dig into AI literacy, digital rights, and civic action. No plane tickets, no visas, no barriers — just your laptop, your voice, and a community of peers who care about the same things you do.

VirtuallyEDU 2.0 unites 7 organizations from 5 countries, each bringing different experience: Folkuniversitetet – FU (Sweden) is a project coordinator, Metropolitan College – MC (Greece) is designing next-level training, Caucasus University – CU and International Black Sea University – IBSU (Georgia) are building the exchange experience, Donetsk National Technical University – DonNTU (Ukraine) is bringing serious AI expertise, EU Innolnstitute – EUI (Ukraine) is powering youth advocacy, and the National Youth Council of Moldova – CNTM is making sure young voices lead the way. One mission, five countries, zero borders.
